



Regulation Officer

The Insolvency Practitioners Association (IPA) is a membership organisation and professional body recognised by the Government for the purposes of licensing members to act as insolvency practitioners. The only such body specialising in insolvency, it has been at the forefront of the profession in creating insolvency qualifications, widening access to insolvency knowledge and understanding, and leading debate on current issues. A team of 20 staff, based in the City of London, is responsible for supporting the IPA's members, affiliates and students, and ensuring that the IPA's brand and reputation are both maintained and enhanced.

The IPA has an interesting and challenging opportunity for someone capable of undertaking a role as regulation officer.

The Job: The successful candidate will be part of a team responsible for the IPA's Putting Better Regulation in Practice standards, monitoring and inspection, as well as providing support for the IPA's representation on the Joint Insolvency Committee of the Recognised Professional Bodies and its own Practice Guidance Ethics & Standards, Personal Insolvency and Corporate Constitution Committees. His/her principal work will include developing risk profiles for IPs; identification of cases for review to be carried out by IPs and consideration of their self-certifications; planning and briefing the team's inspectors for visits to IPs; and participation in other aspects of the team's work and its interface with the IPA's membership and authorisation, complaints investigation and disciplinary operations.
